Distinguished professor of cardiovascular medicine, University of Birmingham (UAB), Alabama, USA. Editor-in-chief of Journal of Echocardiography, Wiley Publications. Considered as the Father of Echocardiography, he pioneered the development of echocardiography. First to discover the pulmonary valve by echocardiography, diagnose a bicuspid aortic valve, develop the echocardiographic technique to diagnose transposition of great arteries in the new born, develop clinical 3D echocardiography and pioneered 3D and 4D echocardiography.

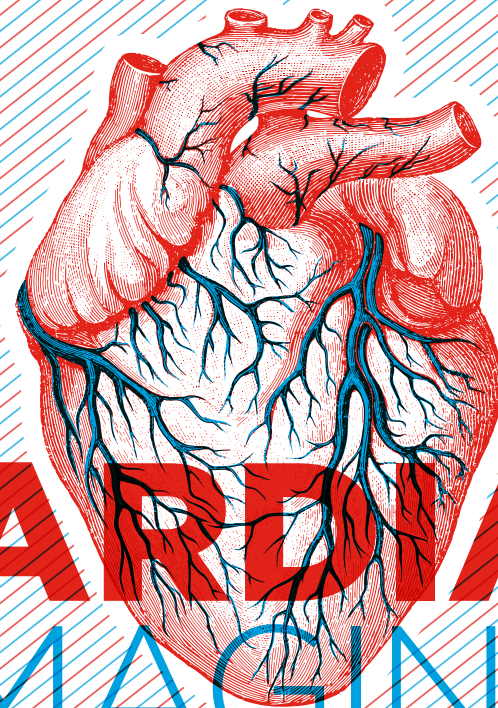
